




SURRENDER OF NASHVILLE EAST BANK OF THE CUMBERLAND
 On Feb. 25, 1862, Nashville became the first Confederate state capital. Cavalry arrived from Bowling Green, KY and set up pickets along the east bank of the river. The Union army, led by General Sherman, surrounded the city and forced the Confederates to surrender.
